

Corona Live May 1st, 2021 Turn it once Everything is included or something like that

Briefly some information about today's May 1st demos, which have degenerated more into anti corona measures - demos, the so-called lateral thinkers are also present in various places, who of course are not on the street because of Labor Day, but around to spread their propaganda on the usual terms. And the classic joke: They are allowed again and again, always violate the requirements on a large scale, the police and those responsible never learn anything new; some are just resistant to the ability to learn. It will be the same today: The talk of a police spokesman in Berlin makes you laugh: If the rules are not adhered to, we will break up the demo. Exactly, it always worked so well in the last demos because many participants simply did not leave the site. Always the same stupid talk. But 5600 police officers in Berlin alone are supposed to enforce the rules and keep everything under control; Exactly, that with 41 registered and approved demos on May 1st alone, yesterday there were already 21 demos and on May 2nd there is still no rest because of Sunday, there are another 20 demos, so in Berlin alone on 3 Days 81 demos (data police Berlin). Then have fun with it. And yesterday you could already get an idea of the peacefulness of some demos, especially with the Antifa guys, because building barriers and other things were dismantled in the urban area of Berlin, which you can use today on May 1st, we will for sure in the evening hours be allowed to follow in the news. And that the police are now even setting up protection zones for journalists, says it all. Where did we go

But the main topic, as always, is the coronavirus situation here in Germany, and it still sucks. Leading political speakers have now insisted on giving the vaccinated citizens back their fundamental rights, the sooner the better. Many talk about it, including our Justice Minister Lamprecht, but have no idea whether it makes sense and is justified in the context of the pandemic. Because everyone should know that 2 vaccinations do not mean that people are immune. Not at all. Instead, according to Prof. Mertens, chairman of the Standing Vaccination Commission (STIKO) at the Robert Koch Institute, an infection will only be so mild that no symptoms are visible on the outside. However, viruses are still released; to what extent the low concentration is still contagious for others is still unclear. And that's exactly the point. Vaccinated people meet unvaccinated people, nobody knows whether the other person carries viruses, since vaccinated people can make contacts without protection, the transmission is easier than ever; apart from that, an unvaccinated person no longer knows whether the person is carrying the virus. The risk of infection increases. But who cares?

My question to the Federal Ministry of Justice, why Ms. Lamprecht supports this with existing knowledge, the answer: That would not be a privilege for vaccinated people, but a requirement of the constitution. By changing the Infection Protection Act, the federal government was authorized to lay down special regulations, exceptions and reliefs for people who are expected to be immunized against the corona virus. She speaks the right thing, but does the wrong thing, because it cannot be assumed today. I've already given reasons. In his answer, the press spokesperson confirms the minister's remarks (whatever else) and mentions the current coordination between the federal government and the federal states for the purpose of preparing the ordinance. The Federal Ministry of Justice agrees with the Federal Ministry of Health under which conditions a sufficient immunization can be assumed.

He and Ms. Lamprecht do not say a clear answer as to whether, in the opinion of the Minister of Justice, the requirements are met across the board for those who have been vaccinated through the vaccination, also for those who have recovered; wise. But I'm already happy if there is an answer at all.

North Rhine-Westphalia and Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania have or will shortly be granting more rights to vaccinated people. And also those who have recovered, although they can become infected

again. But no problem, as it is known, even with the RKI, that vaccination does not offer permanent protection but has to be repeated at least annually, possibly even every six months (nobody knows that), we will notice when the time comes, then the incidence number increases, which says nothing again. And the number of deaths, too, although only a few are interested. How do I get there? When two days ago there were 40 deaths at the celebrations in Israel, which also violated the corona rules, the number was reported every hour in almost all media, the 340 deaths of the day in the matter of Corona in Germany only have the news media such as Welt or NTV reports, NDR Info or similar stations hardly at all. There you can see the importance of so fewer dead. We've already had influenza outbreaks, so what do we want? Incidentally, not my opinion, I've always said that people who aren't interested should have a death in their own family due to Corona, maybe that's interesting.

Interesting statements from Mr. Tschentscher to Markus Lanz. In the direction of retail - and the HDE, which has been arguing for quick (re) openings since the beginning of the pandemic and focuses on the argument that retail is demonstrably not a pandemic driver or a place of new infections, so the lockdown rules are overused and lengthy obsolete. Mr. Tschentscher sees it very differently. His remarks: The concept of testing more and thus having a reason to open up the retail trade is not a solution for him and the wrong approach. It leads to high incidences, not too low. The mistake was opening retail outlets too early in March. But that was the mood at the MPK, where the limit incidence was raised from 35 to 50. Then the retail trade opened up in Germany. Then the numbers went up everywhere. The decision was made at the beginning of March, 2 weeks later the effect was seen in the increase. The price of the openings is much higher than the price of the closings, so his comments. A quick test strategy is not a reason to open, especially for large cities.

Upon request to the HDE on the statements of Mr. Tschentscher, the information that the HDE follows the assessment of the risk of infection when purchasing neutral scientific knowledge. In this context, the HDE refers to studies by the TU Berlin, the RKI and information on studies by the BGHW and BAuA. In these two statements, HDE and Tschentscher, you can see how easily arguments for both directions can be found, both are neither wrong nor refutable. Even if studies assess the risk of infection in retail as low, examples show time and again that shops can also quickly become a source of infection, if z. B. Employees bring the virus with them and are not aware of it. The most recent example I know of is a REWE branch in Bayreuth almost 10 days ago. Furthermore, according to focus.de, the Berlin company NetCheck found out by analyzing anonymized GPS and mobile phone data that around 30 percent of contacts can be traced back to encounters in the food retail trade.

But other interesting remarks came up. It was found after 14 months of a pandemic where many people live in socially deprived areas, many people live in very confined spaces, in districts where the occupational structure allows little or no home office, there are contagion problems. Lanz throws in that the Turkish community needs more information, for example, nobody would talk to them. Many of them are in intensive care units, are not on the vaccination lists. That must change urgently. What is he talking about? JUST migrants, asylum seekers, the Turkish community and other foreigners have more contact points than Germans.

They have support centers for EVERY area of life, and double and triple in every city. In which dream world does the Lanz actually weave? Good objection from Mr. Palmer: The ability to protect yourself and the willingness to obey rules are two pairs of shoes. There are certain milieus with parallel societies that protect themselves less and observe fewer rules. And then comes the question: Can you say that without being confronted with accusations of racism? In his opinion no, you can't, he had to experience it himself. Oops, uncomfortable statements, he revealed something, great outrage on the show. And then the unbelievable happens: Suddenly the show is almost "right in the middle" of this sensitive topic and Lanz quickly gives up. What ?

Another topic: Mask requirement in the train. It doesn't seem to be clear what is duty, law, regulation or whatever. Because: When booking the ticket, the following was displayed (quote) Mask requirement according to statutory Regulation; think of an FFP2 mask (end of quote). However, elsewhere on your website it says: (Quote) DB urgently recommends that its passengers wear FFP2 masks in the interests of health protection on trains and on platforms. However, a recommendation is not mandatory. I wanted to know exactly and asked DB in the press department in Berlin.

The answer that does not provide any clarity: DB urgently recommends that its passengers always wear FFP2 masks in the interests of health protection in trains and on platforms. This corresponds to the requirements of the law for the protection of the population. The law prescribes the FFP2 mask as part of the federal emergency brake. Masks KN 95 / N 95 are also permitted. That is the answer. Here is the current excerpt from the Infection Protection Act / Lower Saxony Ordinance (quote) ... a respiratory protection mask (FFP2 or comparable) or a medical face mask (mouth and nose protection) must be worn. Where is the legal obligation FFP2? I can't see Make the most of it when you take the train. And the right thing.

India theme. Not a day goes by without us pointing out the dire situation with regard to Corona and seeing dramatic pictures and films on television. And as I predicted two weeks ago, of course Germany will be there again to cart aid deliveries to India. India has vaccinated almost as many citizens as the USA and is therefore third behind China with the most vaccinations. Sure, then the vaccine runs out. But the media portrayed India as receiving far too little vaccine. Not exactly, almost 10 times as much as Germany, where just 23 million received the first vaccination and around 7.5 million the second, India has already vaccinated a good 130 million citizens, for comparison. But why has the outbreak in India increased so dramatically in the last few weeks, before the numbers were far down? Informed people recognize in this the consequence of the many religious festivals in India that India has celebrated in the last few weeks. No distance, no mask, crowded streets and squares close together with body contact, considering the population, someone wonders that the virus has increased explosively here, plus the Indian coronavirus. But stupidity is still rewarded by the federal government and German taxpayers have to take responsibility for it. To clarify for eternally complaining: This is not about the fact that I am against aid for really needy countries, but if I consciously promote the contagion as a state, I can not expect and also do not deserve to get support in case of problems. Apart from that: While Germany is still stuck in the group of 60+ year olds when it comes to vaccinating because of insufficient vaccination doses, there are now vaccinations for all adults over 18 without prioritization in India. Because they have so little vaccine or what?

It doesn't help if a vaccination center in Neuss is presented on television as the record vaccination center in terms of speed. It's nice that 1900 people are vaccinated there every day and that a vaccination is carried out every 2.5 minutes. If there were enough vaccine, it would even manage 2,600 people. Really great. And then another hint: Because so-called syringe holders are used there, a few seconds can be saved. What's the nonsense? Is it now possible to vaccinate in a matter of seconds? Whether it takes 2.5 minutes, 3 minutes or even 5 minutes, who cares? Don't we have anything more important to do than stop the time, how long it takes? Perhaps we will soon be presented with the vaccination center, which will take the longest? So as a center of shame. I can only hold my head about what's going on here. They should do their job there and be good. The other nonsense about speed really doesn't interest anyone, we have asked interviews from citizens who think it's important here too.
