

Corona lies cover-ups unbelievable 11/01/2020

46.2 million infections worldwide, Germany reached 540,000 with 10,509 deaths

TOP 4 world infection rates: USA 9.1 million, India 8.2 million, Brazil 5.5 million, Russia 1.6 million. The 3 largest EU infection countries: France 1.4 million cases, Spain 1.2 million cases, Italy around 709,000. Almost 1,197,000 deaths worldwide. Argentina Colombia England over 1 million.

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Today I would like to tell you not only new things from the "corona scene", but also things that you will hardly believe. But believe me, I couldn't say anything here that I can't prove. It all starts "harmlessly".

Since March 2020 we have had the dilemma of wearing masks, keeping our distance, taking shopping carts in shops and more. At least the vast majority of the population; and me too. So far. But the more rules are made, which politicians sometimes fail to adhere to, athletes sometimes do what they want, medical presidents doubt the mask as protection, and certainly not outside, in the Bundestag the mask requirement is constantly violated, then again and again like a prayer wheel Calls to the population to do everything the politicians want, and then you see politicians after a press conference, when the cameras are supposedly gone, the masks are removed, in the credits of Anne Will last week everyone suddenly stands together and talks; Without a mask and distance, and so it runs through the TV world from week to week. But the citizens should stick to everything, and don't worry, then there will be a hefty fine.

A classic example here in Göttingen on Friday: On Wednesday, the number of infections was published at just under 36 and a recommendation was made to wear the mask in public in the city center. If the value rises above 50, then from this Monday mask would be mandatory in the city center. I stand in line at a bakery outside on Friday, without a mask. A woman from the Göttingen public order office approaches me, I would like to put on my mask, please. I reply that it is not mandatory to wear a mask until Monday. She replies that the value is already over 50 and that the duty would probably come on Saturday. I reply: On Saturday, but not today. Then she complains that I would not stand in front of the Plexiglas pane, then the mask requirement would apply. Also outside. The first question comes to me: does she want to talk me into the mask because of the missing pane or because of the upcoming duty? I take a step to the right and stand in front of the window. So now I'm standing in front of the window and don't need a mask, I tell her. She replies: I would not have stood in front of it before. The gibberish is enough for me and I point out that she could like to see my certificate if she wanted. But they don't care. In the meantime I have my rolls (otherwise the saleswoman didn't say anything from the start) and go. The force of order remains behind.

Back home I called the press office in Göttingen, who did not want to make a statement. The public order office could not be reached despite an estimated 10 calls and dial tones. Just an example of what's going on here. Now on to other topics. Just for the sake of clarity: I am not a mask refuser and I wear these for my own protection in buses and when shopping and where I consider it necessary, but I am against arbitrariness and stupidity, and decidedly.

As we all know, the corona numbers have recently exploded in Germany. Many people talk about it, no problem, we have enough intensive care beds, and there are still so many empty (there are not that many anymore, because many are not occupied by corona patients, but by other patients). Over 70% are already occupied, did you know that? And that's not all. It is of no use that we could convert 12,000 beds to intensive care beds, because there is simply no staff to be able to look after them. Spahn and

Co. prefer not to talk about that, it doesn't fit into the talk of "Don't panic, Germany is doing well". What you should know: There are already serious considerations, should the nursing staff become scarce, also let staff who have tested positive work. No joke. The RKI has already announced that, in the event of a shortage of staff, qualified nursing staff will be granted permission to work even if the test is positive. The RKI emphasized that this would only be permitted if there was a relevant staff shortage. In addition, the staff would have to wear so-called FFP2 masks and should only look after infected patients. How reassuring. Would you like to be "looked after" by an infected nurse? The German Professional Association for Nursing Professions (DBfK) also rejects this resolutely.

According to the latest findings, there is already a shortage of around 4,000 skilled nurses, so the topic "relevant" is already relevant.

If Spahn and Co. always talk about we have enough beds, we have enough staff and are constantly increasing here and there, then of course that is only half the story: Nursing staff do not grow out of the ground and people from Vietnam, Brazil and If you are carted here from elsewhere than alleged nursing staff, you first have to get used to it, and that is doubly difficult, especially in Corona times. In addition: If everything is as rosy as some politicians want us to know, why are non-Corona patients sent home again, operations postponed in order to have enough staff and beds free? Spahn calls it "well positioned" when a patient who reports live in front of the camera that her cancer operation has been postponed by 3 months has now been found that the cells have scattered and it is questionable whether the operation is still of any use ? But I understand that we cannot take individual fates into account. What is the person worth in this time, I mean after a press conference and without a camera and witnesses?

Germany meanwhile declares more and more foreign areas as risk areas, almost completely Austria and Italy are affected, plus Croatia, Slovenia, Hungary, Bulgaria and Cyprus. Areas in Greece, Latvia, Denmark, Portugal, Sweden and Lithuania are also added. The 3 smallest states Monaco, San Marino and the Vatican are now included. The same rule also applies abroad: more than 50 on a seven-day average, then a risk area. Especially in the small states, the number can of course be reached quickly, San Marino with around 34,000 residents, Monaco with around 40,000 and the Vatican with only 825 residents only need a few contagions to break the threshold. And on the lamentable topic of the Germans, your rights to freedom, leisure time and the like would be curtailed: Let's take a look at Austria, it's a very different matter (excerpt: Exit restrictions: leaving your own private living area is prohibited between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. Exceptions are only very narrow. And the citizens survive that too.

I also want to shed light on the subject of vaccination protection, which everyone rushes to and more or less hopes to be ready by the end of the year, and sometimes come out as a fairy tale of lies. Of course, various laboratories are working on it, but they are nowhere near as far as some people would like us to believe. These are only slogans to persevere, so that the citizens will continue to support the measures, since an alleged end is in sight. The supposed truth is spread on NTV by a Dr. med. Christoph Specht, who has received prizes for film, less for medical services, and also declares on his homepage that he has no practice and does not treat. More like a medical journalist. His admission is as follows: The vaccination commission announced that, contrary to many assumptions, that the vaccinations will be through in the spring of next year, so to speak, and then everything will be fine again until the end of 2021 and even 2022. The vaccination has to start first and you can't vaccinate that many people, and the vaccine has to be stored separately. Interesting for attentive viewers of the video on NTV: In the background you can clearly see several x-rays of a skull, uh, I hadn't read, he doesn't practice at all and doesn't have a practice? Make yourself a picture of the credibility of Dr. med. Woodpecker.

The retail trade is back, the whining has started again in view of the limitations of the space that must be available per customer. This is underpinned by poorer sales figures in September 2020. In return, the figures in the previous months were surprisingly good, in some cases above the previous year's average. As always, there are winners and losers, depending on the product. And online is the TOP winner as always, I will not complain about the reasons anymore, they are well known. In the meantime, retailers could also have opened an online shop, obviously little zest in this direction. And the advice from a trade association that fewer customers are likely to come to the city centers due to contact restrictions is of course nonsense. As many citizens are allowed to be on the streets as before, or have you heard that a maximum number of people is permitted on each street? Really nonsense. Which is correct, that only 1 customer is allowed per 10 square meters. And ? It has always been the case with small shops that only one is in the shop at a time, and I know business chains who only want to let in half of the permitted number because they are afraid of contamination. The trade association does not talk about that, which is also voluntary.

It is also clear that because of the upcoming closings of bars, restaurants, etc., the wave of lawsuits will kick off again nationwide from next week, and again it will be said: In this and that federal state, shops are allowed to open again, in the federal state that is the case and so blah blah blah. It's also fun to complain in the FRG, lawyer flat rate sends greetings. The companies are bracing themselves against their threatened bankruptcies, you say? Nonsense, I say, they get reimbursed 75% of the previous year's sales, incidentally more than any employee who is sent on short-time work. And self-employed people who also complain? On the one hand, I think that has a little to do with job risk, if someone isn't hired, he won't get anything. But nothing is wrong at all, they too are now happy with this 75% despite paying 0 into the social system. So what's the whining? Incidentally, the first urgent applications have already been received by the courts because of the closings. And anyone wondering about it: If even Bundestag Vice-President Kubicki calls for resistance to the measures of the lockdown, you need not be surprised when the population is heated up. Anyone who has heard Mrs Merkel's speech in the Bundestag and the many boos and intermittent heckling, knows that the mood against the measures is also increasing in the Bundestag.

Again there are companies and facilities where corona cases are increasing. In addition to a meat processing company, there is also a nursing home in Frankfurt. And now I have to be surprised: The residents are unlikely to have brought the virus in, it is more likely to come from one or more employees. But 90% of those drive to work by car, the family members of whom were previously infected, do not know, because otherwise it would have been quarantine. So where did the employees get infected from? Celebrated together, even not following the rules privately? I would be interested in that. The fact is, the residents are stupid: 46 have now been infected by 22 employees, one resident has already died. A really great masterpiece, the one on the subject: We have an outstanding hygiene and distance concept, so why all the restrictions?

So if the tough measures apply from next week, the regulatory agencies should also be supported by the police, including the federal police. But even with the officials it is becoming apparent what it means to be among the refusers. Around 200 federal police officers are now infected, plus over 1,700 family members who are in quarantine due to the infection, according to the Rheinische Post on October 31, 2020. In NRW, too, the law enforcement officers are to be supported by "hundreds" of the police so that they can do justice to their control tasks.

While the RKI reported "only" around 19,000 new infections yesterday compared to the previous day, today only around 14,000; Clearly on Sunday, there are no nationwide reports, reports a well-known newspaper that was published on October 30th. the number went over 20,000 for the first time, exactly 20,135. Allegedly, the figures come from the state health and social ministries, which probably publish other "more current" figures on their websites than those processed by the RKI, wherever

there is always a backlog. In this respect, not only a leading German football club, but also Germany has now achieved the triple, congratulations with the help of the mask and distance refusers: over 500,000 infections, over 10,000 deaths and over 20,000 new infections in one day. In order for us to stay close to our hard-earned numbers, a court once again overturned the mask requirement during a lateral thinking demo, keep it up, we still want to create new records. Do the judges also belong to the lateral thinkers? In particular because of the party-mad people, Prof. Lauterbach warned that a control of private apartments was sensible and appropriate, even necessary, and the "inviolability of the apartment" should not be an argument. And already people are getting excited, especially on social forums on the Internet; because they have no idea. And so violently that relevant criminal offenses and the resulting reports will follow: The death of Prof. Lauterbach is openly demanded and someone should declare himself ready for it, even there is talk of execution. Which sick brains are behind such postings? The government should slowly notice that such people cannot be reached with a "persevere slogan". Much tougher measures are needed here. And for all the stupid people who have spread such slogans and still do it: The police are always allowed into the apartment in the event of well-founded suspicion or imminent danger, so if it can be seen from the street that the apartment is full, they can Police also check whether that suits someone or not. This is not possible without justification. To the posters of these calls: Turn on your brain, no matter how small it is. Thuringia's Prime Minister also sees the ever-increasing willingness to use violence against police officers as a threat to internal security, and protesters are increasingly merciless. This is shown by the events on Berlin's Museum Island or large photos of Prof. Drosten and Ms. Merkel in concentration camp clothing, carried along at a demo. Journalists are also increasingly affected.

Meanwhile, some critics are cursing Mr. Söder; because of the corona situation in Bavaria; All districts are now red or dark red, reacted, and saddled up again to the measures decided: 2 households, 10 people, this also applies to private apartments. Events of ALL kinds are initially prohibited until the end of November. It could be necessary to declare a disaster in the next few days. The intensive care beds are already occupied in the first districts, and it must be avoided. Within the last 9 days, the occupancy of the intensive care beds has doubled, so Söder at the announcement before the state parliament.

On my own account, I would like to point out that I have recently been receiving press information and photos on alleged rapid tests, even faster tests, vaccination doses that will soon be available, etc. Everything is very nice, but I will not publish this because I cannot check the accuracy of the content and I do not advertise for pharmaceuticals and lobbyists. If at some point a product is approved and certified accordingly, that is a different matter.

I had already written several times by von Altmaier's suggestion to allow Sunday openings as compensation for sales losses and clearly refuted his incorrect presentation. But what the board of the German Council of Shopping Places, formerly the German Council of Shopping Centers e.V., is now proposing in the matter of Harald Ortner really blows everyone away. He also wants Sunday openings to compensate, but here it comes: He wants the 4 Sundays in Advent and the 2 Sundays after Christmas for additional shopping. I can only urge every retail employee, trade unionist, church and other well-meaning and realist to give this gentleman a chance. B. to explain by email what you think of it and why 6 days more openings can hardly compensate for the loss of sales from months, and certainly not avert bankruptcies. Pure populism. But then I can reassure you a little: This association has a total of 750 members, a fraction of whom are retailers. Insofar an uninteresting opinion.

I would like to touch on a small complex of topics before I come to today's highlight, keyword Thai King. The subject is the re-emerging panic of buying, hamster buying, panic buying, what do I know how that is called. Frau Glöckner had tried to calm everyone down, as always. As always, everyone is talking about the topic small, but then I wonder why a large report is being published on NTV at these times in which the Federal Office for Disaster Protection is named and it is explicitly pointed out which

basic equipment should be available for everyone . And that's not all: Drinks, food and weight, even the average daily calorie requirement, are mentioned in detail that should be available. There are also recommendations for medical care, general items, drugstore items and - lo and behold - sufficient toilet paper is mentioned. There you are. So my toilet paper lasts until the end of the year - normally. Speaking of toilet paper: Did you know that Austria was the first and probably only country in the world to print a postage stamp on the subject of Corona - on toilet paper. YES, on toilet paper. The stamp or the piece of printed toilet paper costs 5.50 euros and includes a donation of 50% for help for Corona. There is both mint and stamped toilet paper and on first day covers. Do not you believe ? NO fake, just check the website of the Austrian Post. The picture will be submitted later as it is protected by copyright and I am currently in the process of clarifying the publication.

Now, at the end of the day, the highlight for me: It's about the Thai king, against whom at least parts of the population in their own country take to the streets for their rights, and the German embassy there is said to have already been besieged. Meanwhile, the king is supposed to continue his official business from Germany, which Mr. Maaß has complained several times about, because that is not permissible, it will not be allowed. If this is confirmed, that will have consequences. Ms. Sasse, Foreign Office, preferred not to comment on possible measures and consequences. Also, when asked what consequences and measures are available, no statement is made. When asked how it was checked whether the king was carrying out government affairs from German soil, no answer. When the journalist says that when asked, of course the government will say what one would like to hear, Ms. Sasse's statement: You have other means of finding out which, she does not say. A clever question from a journalist: He's constantly traveling back and forth between Munich and Thailand; Do the corona requirements and quarantine also apply there? The spokeswoman Ms. Haijebi from the Ministry of Health has no answer and hesitantly says: The rules apply to everyone, we have not made any exceptions, maybe the Ministry of the Interior can help how kings are treated. Mr. Lammert Ministry of the Interior: Not about kings but about entry regulations in general. He only talks about the fact that Thailand is on the positive list and therefore no entry restrictions apply. Demand: There is information that the king is currently not allowed to enter Germany. Lammert: I can only speak of the positive list. And again the clever question of a journalist: That would mean in the end that the king should not have been allowed to enter the country as long as Thailand was not on the positive list? The expression on Mr. Lammert's face shows, oops, now he's got me. First wordless facial expressions, then the journalist adds: He would have been traveling back and forth for a long time. Lammert: I can't say anything about the king's travel activities, but the quarantine regulations apply in any case - and refers back to the Ministry of Health. But there is no answer, then Lammert reports back with the 1a answer: The individual federal states are responsible for the quarantine regulations, I cannot give an answer about this. The ping-pong game worked out well. The core question, rules with the king, cleverly veiled and the answer covered up, is what the government plays at these so-called federal press conferences. It is not for nothing that some journalists have complained that they are getting fewer and fewer concrete answers. Then why are you going to the federal press conference? Think about it.

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
