

## Corona News 05/10/2021 New mobile test centers and more

Today my current report starts from Göttingen. As some loyal readers still remember, Göttingen was on television several months ago, the focus of coronavirus outbreaks in 2 large living areas that are overly inhabited by refugees, migrants, asylum seekers and Roma. NOW, after 15 months of pandemic, the idea comes to Göttingen, people have language problems, reservations about visiting doctors, visiting test centers and more. That is why Göttingen has decided to set up several (so far 4) mobile test centers that can be used directly on site. Today at 9 a.m. the mobile test center in Hagenweg 20, one of the problem areas in Göttingen, started.

As if that didn't fit, the company Allround Service Logistics GmbH, which actually offers moving and storage services, has taken on this task. At least logistically, provided one of the transporters. The equipment was accordingly sparse: 2 tables and a chair in the storage area, entrance at the back through the loading door, exit at the side through the sliding door. 2 medical employees in the car take the test and handle all work. Registration on a round party table in front of the car. If necessary, FFP2 masks are made available; there was excessive interest in this.

Ms. Broistedt, on the Corona staff in Göttingen, explained: There is a 2-language flyer as information that informs the residents about the possibilities. Every Monday from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m., the mobile vehicle was parked in front of the living facility. More are in front of the Idunazentrum and the rear area Groner Landstr. 9 / 9a, every Tuesday, Groner Landstr. 10 a.m. - 1 p.m. and then at the Idunazentrum 1 p.m. - 5 p.m. These are the free citizen tests that are paid for at least once a week. When asked, a team of 15 people would look after the mobile centers. Your statement that the city intends to further expand the mobile test centers is interesting. Where now everyone is relying on vaccination and the tests are less. Especially since the general practitioners can test as well as vaccinate; the coverage of the doctors is great. There are 2 general practitioners in the immediate vicinity of Hagenweg 20, and there are doctors in the Iduna Center itself. In this respect, the sudden action with the importance it makes is a bit strange.

So much from Göttingen. Of course there is also more to report. So from China. The Chinese vaccine against corona from Sinopharm has now been approved by the WHO via emergency approval. The effectiveness is said to be 80% and is suitable for people aged 18 and over. China has a second vaccine that is currently being tested.

Let us turn to the easing for vaccinated and convalescent people that is taking place today in Göttingen as well, but in many places in Germany. In response to pressure, the Bundestag has now implemented these easing measures; Obviously, however, many have no experience or knowledge of how safe those who have recovered and who have been vaccinated actually are, especially in relation to other people. Everyone and also Mr. Spahn pretend that these people are immune to everything and that they are completely harmless to the others. Which is not true at all, it seems like that to me, the main thing is to get things done, because the viruses aren't really that active in summer. And funny: Suddenly the number of infections and deaths is falling so rapidly that the question arises, why? What has changed from today to last week? Nothing. It's strange, but now we know that the RKI sometimes makes strange peculiarities in the counts, uncovered by the journalist Reitschuster, who is best known for his uncomfortable questions at the federal press conferences and sometimes annoys Seibert and Co. Special features mean that refugees and refugees of the most varied of status among the population are counted, but not among the infected, and more.

But the German Ethics Council made an important statement in the person of Sigrid Graumann a few days ago: The vaccination protects against getting seriously ill with Corvid 19, but according to the current state of knowledge it does not reliably protect against becoming infected and especially against infecting others . Why is that just being ignored? Prof. Wieler also said at the Federal Press Conference:

Until we can largely do without measures and rules, the number of immunities in the population must be well over 80% either through a complete vaccination or through an infection + vaccination with the predominant virus variant B117. Even then there will still be infections, there will also be outbreaks, but there will be no more waves. Then we will have the pandemic under control. Like right now ? 80%, we are now at around 10% of those who have been vaccinated twice, why do you give everything free for 10% now? And Mr Spahn says: It is still unclear how long the vaccination will last and when you will have to be vaccinated again (The statement is interesting, which means: It is clear that the vaccination does not last long, but nobody knows how long it will work ).

This also means that at some point vaccinated people walk around as safe people who are no longer safe, and everything starts all over again. Great concept, Mr. Spahn and Co. Wieler added on request: The vaccination offer will be there for months and years. (That makes me happy) The citizens will be offered a vaccination again if the study situation indicates when it will be necessary. At the moment the knowledge is not available here. We will have to vaccinate more often, that is clear. But we just can't tell you the time intervals yet. Thank you, we don't need the whole concept of curfew, freedom of movement is here, I'll say it with clear words: For the rubbish bin.

And about the vaccine AstraZeneca, where we have all known for weeks what problems exist with it and have prevailed up to the vaccination stop and again approval, a vaccine doctor in charge according to NTV from Cologne gives an interview in which he recommends Astra Zeneca without reservation. He says that AstraZeneca has a better effectiveness than all flu substances of the last 20 years combined, which would have been 60%, Astra has 76 - 79%. It was said to be 100% effective against severe courses such as hospitalization. He also found it difficult to endure the discussion of side effects. I can imagine that AstraZeneca is way ahead of any flu vaccine.

He prefers to talk about the fact that the other two mRNA vaccines have higher rates. But it's always bad to compare yourself to worse vaccines, maybe you should do it with better ones. And when it comes to brain thrombosis, he can no longer hear either. You can treat that. From the 4th day to the doctor with a headache. Exactly, and if you already have the thrombosis on the 2nd or 3rd day, then you're just unlucky. He prefers to talk about it, there are days when he has Astra or no vaccine. Everyone has to decide for themselves whether they prefer Corona or Astra. So I don't like either, and even after 15 months I haven't got either, and I'm still very healthy. The Corona infection doesn't seem that big if you follow all the rules. If you listen to the doctor, you might think that you will get vaccinations or corona, that is the choice.

Finally another kind of punch line. About the usefulness of the tests. Bild reported a few days ago. Before flying from India to Hong Kong, all passengers were tested and found negative. On arrival in Hong Kong, 53 passengers tested positive. Obviously, the viruses attached themselves to the outside of the aircraft and penetrated during the flight and carried out a rapid infection.
