

Corona News 04/22/2021 Emergency brake from Friday or not

Just in these minutes, around 1:15 p.m., the meeting of the Federal Council came to an end, the deliberations and discussions on the amendment to the Infection Protection Act are over, the live broadcast from the meeting was interrupted on TV just where the vote was due. Coincidence or intent? It has become clear, however, that not only some of the prime ministers disagree with some regulations, points that have been taken up in countries, have not been introduced, etc. There are country representatives who secretly hope that the law will be overturned by the Federal Constitutional Court. And since at least one association of dealers has already announced the lawsuit, and there are still a few private plaintiffs, it is to be expected that this law will only last in this version for a short time, if at all. The Federal Council has since waded through despite concerns and Steinmeier has probably already signed it. So far that is clear. But this is hardly clear, there are already indications of judgments by courts that have tilted curfews due to Corona as unlawful, the Hanover Administrative Court and the Lüneburg Higher Administrative Court were named here. The Federal Constitutional Court judges independently, but prejudices always have a certain sign, the more there are.

The timetable is as follows: Adopted in the Bundestag on Wednesday, waded through today in the Bundesrat, signed by the Federal President, from tomorrow on, on Friday April 23rd, 2021 it should be implemented in the federal states or affected circles. Strange. The law will take effect on Thursday, and on Friday, for example, B. to adjust retail according to this, i.e. within 1 day? At Easter it was said by Ms. Merkel that the 10 days up to the 2 planned rest days were too short for retailers to adapt. Do you notice what? Pure dumbing down of the people.

But also interesting what some prime ministers say there. So the Prime Minister Tobias Hans von Saarland. Has no medical knowledge of virology or epidemiology, but feels called to claim that the high incidence numbers are of course clearly caused by the tests, which is why the incidence number is worthless as a benchmark, so to speak. He speaks of a 30% share in the incidence number, but should know better if he informs himself as well as his colleagues: The tests should have an influence between 10 - 30%, he immediately chooses the highest number in order to make the number meaningful to discredit to the maximum. Apart from that, his theory does not work, there is nothing more than that, for a second reason: How can it then be explained that the incidence figures only fell at the end of last year despite the sharp increase in tests? Then the numbers would have had to rise permanently. He doesn't know and doesn't want to explain. He prefers to talk about a kind of disempowerment of the prime ministers, a part of their decision would be taken away from them. After all, there was a reason to introduce federalism. What Mr. Hans forgets: In 1949, when this was introduced, we had never had a global pandemic like this. And since the prime ministers have impressively demonstrated, especially at the latter conferences, how great they work together and even throw agreed rules over here and there a day later, what is needed is "a strong force" to create rules or laws all of which must then be observed. Because they are unable to discipline themselves. Others are upset that one can control the outbreaks in individual companies well. If so, why are the numbers so high that they should be under 10 or what? The countries just don't have it under control, almost daily new reports of outbreaks in companies, sometimes an entire hospital, then an old people's home (still), then a REWE store. It's different every day. So manageable. We had stupid talk for a long time, now new steps and new measures are necessary.

Mr. Spahn, as an advocate of the new legislation, again shows the urgency. Around a third of all corona patients in hospitals die, 50% of them artificially ventilated patients, according to Mr. Lauterbach. Apart from that, he sees Germany on the right path in terms of vaccinations, from May the last prioritization group of the 60+ group should be able to get vaccination appointments, from June the

prioritization should then be completely lifted. But the topic of vaccinations and intensive care beds is of course also a daily topic in social media and on the street, for example at demos. Yesterday in Berlin, again demos in different places, partly approved, partly unapproved, with usual violations. In front of them is a woman with a megaphone who loudly announces that she knows many doctors and medical professionals, that the intensive care beds are not overloaded and that most of them are empty.

And then another woman, an intensive care nurse from a hospital, who tells in a TV program how difficult it is to care for all intensive care patients with Corona, because more and more are added, even at a young age. And it is now the case again that non-urgent operations are postponed in order of course to keep the remaining beds as free as possible. Which of the two is more believable now? I don't think I have to say anything about that, but something general: Logically, intensive care beds are empty, but why? Woman no. 1, turn on the brain, then she may also come up with it: Could it be that we have heart attack / stroke / accident patients every day or patients who have to go to the intensive care unit after an urgent operation, get an artificial coma and other things more? And is it possible that there are not enough intensive care staff to maintain all beds? Thinking outside the box can be nice and right, but not thinking at all is bad. Best example here.

But what is being reported in the media today, by the way: For a long time (whatever that means) Turkish residents with a gray ID card from the Federal Republic of Germany are said to have entered Germany illegally and then went into hiding, some of them have a job on construction or other odd jobs accepted to make ends meet. These ID cards should only be issued by municipalities, mayors etc. in Turkey, due to the large number it seems to be a kind of distribution, so it is assumed. But what I'm getting at: These people can at least also import Corona, which nobody controls because they do not exist at first. The question of why all of a sudden more corona cases suddenly appear in companies where the proportion of foreigners is high. We had tons of them last year.

Some interesting statements at the federal press conference on April 19, 2021. A message about the distribution of the vaccines. How and where do the vaccines actually come from? Lt. For the Federal Ministry of Health, it works like this that the federal states first register their needs for the vaccination centers, so-called excess contingents then go to the practices. This statement actually amazes me, I didn't even know that we have over-contingents that nobody wants or needs. Ms. Demmer, deputy government spokeswoman, mentioned that around 10% of corona patients would suffer long-term effects. When asked how she knows this: There are no studies or reliable evidence for this, there are indications of this value. When asked by Mr Jung about what he said was an arbitrary number of emergency brakes in schools from now 165, i.e. reduced from 200, no information where this number comes from, but also good news: the German Olympic athletes will be sent to Tokyo and yes, you will receive the necessary vaccinations in a timely manner. Meanwhile, 3 federal states, Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania, Saxony and Bavaria have released AstraZeneca for everyone, regardless of age. Funny, the last reports from STIKO and Co. were called that they should only be vaccinated from 60 onwards. There are probably old excess stocks that have to go, and everyone is right.

Actually, I didn't want to write about violations of Corona anymore, because they are the order of the day, but in this particularly blatant case I think it's right to make it known. Crime scene Cologne. A party with around 30 participants who, after being discovered and visited by the police, behave like small children and sometimes want to flee, sometimes hide. The perfidious thing: Among the participants there should have been some medical professionals who tried to get out of the affair with stupid sayings such as: Ridiculous action, you are yourself a doctor and similar slogans. My statement on this: Determine personal details and place of work, notify the employer, dismiss without notice, there are also nice jobs that do not require so much intelligence.

Since the vaccine from Johnson & Johnson has not yet been delivered to Germany due to similar problems that have already occurred with other vaccines, trust in the company is now being sustainably strengthened, which some politicians always propagate, or should I tell the truth : Allegedly, the pharmaceutical company is said to have misrepresented the risks of a certain painkiller, i.e. downplayed them. As early as 2019, the company was fined \$ 465 million in the US, the decision of the appeal is still pending.

As we all know, the corona crisis is really costing the German state money, not only because of the countless financial aid that has been provided and is still to come, not to mention the failures because companies are now going bankrupt and will continue to go for longer the whole thing lasts and then no repayment is made. In addition, there are exorbitant payments in the health sector for research, Ms. Karliczek can sing a song, but she prefers to talk about herself and her great successes. In the area of Corona research alone, over 1.5 billion euros have flowed in around 18 months, a large part to Biontech and also Curevac, but the latter are having a hard time. One institution alone has 20 research groups in the field of bacterial and viral pathogens, headed by 16 Prof. Dr. , 3x Prof and 1x Dr. That's why I write this in such detail for ONE institution when I think about what Corona news / findings have surfaced within a year, but in my opinion the results are rather low, and a good 30 million euros is a handsome sum. As I said, this example concerns ONE institution, of course there are various people involved. As you can see, I deliberately did NOT mention the name of the institution. This fits in with the latest reports that the incidence, especially in children, is increasing more and more, why this is so is unexplained - and obviously also unexplored until now.

One more special message at the end: Now the highest point on earth has its first corona case: On Mount Everest, more precisely in a camp in front of the peak, a Norwegian with an infection was flown to the hospital by helicopter. Now Nepal fears for its tourists and mountaineers - and rightly so. The easing that was only introduced in March was therefore a failure.
